CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE MEMBERS AGAINST CHILD LABOUR

- It will be the responsibility of the Members to ensure that no child labour, prohibited by the Child Labour [Prohibition & Regulation] Act, 1986 is employed in the production of the handicrafts, either in their own premises or, in case of outsourcing of work, in the premises of the entity to which the work has been outsourced.
- In case of violation of the Code of Conduct, a Show-Cause Notice will be issued to the members by giving him/her an opportunity to explain the circumstances under which the violation has been made.
- The explanation so received will be placed before the Committee of Administration to enable it to decide action to be taken in respect of that violation.
- In case a member is found guilty of violating any of the terms of the Code of Conduct for more than two occasions, the EPCH will put case before the Committee of Administration for a decision regarding de-registration of such members.
- The Committee of Administration may de-register a member after giving him an opportunity to appear and defend himself before the Committee.
- It will be the responsibility of each member to ensure strict compliance of the Code of Conduct.
- The Code of Conduct shall apply to all members of the Council.
